

# Cartwheel Place Mat



Crochet this beautiful place mat from the early 60's.

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(Note: These products may no longer be available. You'll need to substitute with cotton thread and colors of your choice.)

DAISY Mercerized Crochet Cotton, Art. 65, in White, Size 20

No. 12 Steel Crochet Hook.

**1st MOTIF:** Starting in center, ch 2

**RND 1:** 8 sc in 2nd ch from hook, join with sl st in 1<sup>st</sup> sc.

**RND 2:** Ch 10, tr in next sc, (ch 5, tr in next sc) 6 times, ch 5, join to 5<sup>th</sup> st of ch-10.

**RND 3:** Ch 1, sc in same st, (in next ch-5 sp make 1 hdc, 2 dc, 3 tr, 2 dc and 1 hdc; sc in next tr) repeated around; join to 1st sc, sl st in next 3 sts.

**RND 4:** Ch 5, dc in next st, \* ch 2, (tr, ch 5, tr) in next (center) st, (ch 2 dc, in next st) twice, dc in 3<sup>rd</sup> st on next scallop, ch 2, dc in next st; re-

peat from \* around; join to 3<sup>rd</sup> st of ch-5, sl st to next dc.

**RND 5:** Ch 3, \* 2 dc in next sp, dc in next tr, in ch-5 sp make a shell of 3 dc, ch 5 and 3 dc; dc in next tr, 2 dc in next sp, dc in next dc, sk 2 dc in angle, dc in next dc; repeat from \* around; join to ch-3, sl st in next 2 dc.

**RND 6:** Ch 3, dc in next 4 dc, \* in ch-5 sp make a shell of 3 dc, ch 5 and 3 dc; dc in next 5 dc, sk 4 dc in angle (2 on each point), dc in next 5 dc; repeat from \* around; join to ch 3, sl st in next 2 dc.

**RND 7:** Ch 3, (dc in next 5 dc, shell in next sp, dc in next 6 dc, ch 2, dc in 3<sup>rd</sup> dc on next point) repeated around; join final ch 2 to 1<sup>st</sup> ch 3, sl st in next 2 dc.

**RND 8:** Ch 3, (dc in next 6 dc, shell in next sp, dc in next 7 dc, ch 9, dc in 3<sup>rd</sup> dc on next point) repeat around; join, sl st in next 3 dc.

**RND 9:** Ch 3, \* dc in next 6 dc, shell in next sp, dc in next 7 dc, ch 2, (dc, ch 5, dc) in next ch 9 lp, ch 2, dc in 4<sup>th</sup> dc on next point; repeat from \* around; join, sl st in next 4 dc.

**RND 10:** Ch 3, \* dc in next 5 dc, shell in next sp, dc in next 6 dc, ch 2, dc in 1<sup>st</sup> dc between points, ch 2, (dc, ch 5, dc) in next sp, ch 2, dc in next dc, ch 2, dc in 5<sup>th</sup> dc in next point; repeat from \* around; join, sl st in next 5 dc.

**RND 11:** Ch 3, \* dc in next 3 dc, shell in next sp, dc in next 4 dc, (ch 2, dc in next dc between points) twice, ch 2, (dc, ch 5, dc) in next sp, (ch 2, dc in next dc) twice, ch 2 dc in 6<sup>th</sup> dc on next point; repeat from \* around; join.

**RND 12:** Ch 1, sc in same st, sc in

next 6 dc, \* (1 hdc, 5 dc and 1 hdc) in next sp, sc in next 7 dc, (2 sc in next sp, sc in next dc, ch 4, sl st in last sc for a picot) 3 times, (3 sc, picot, 3 sc) in next sp, (sc in next dc, a picot, 2 sc in next sp) 3 times, sc in next 7 dc; repeat from \* around; join and fasten off.

**2ND MOTIF:** Repeat to \* in Rnd 12; (1 hdc and 3 dc) in half of next sp, sl st in center dc on 1 point on 1<sup>st</sup> Motif, (2 dc and 1 hdc) in bal. of sp; continue to center picot of lacy pattern between points, in place of picot ch 2, sl in corresponding picot on 1<sup>st</sup> Motif, ch, 2, sl st back in last sc; continue to next point and join that to next point on 1<sup>st</sup> Motif as previous point was joined. Complete rnd as for 1<sup>st</sup> Motif.

**3RD Motif:** Sk one lacy pattern on 2<sup>nd</sup> Motif, then join 3<sup>rd</sup> Motif to next point, next lacy pattern and following point.

**4TH Motif:** Join in same way to 1<sup>st</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> Motifs.

**CENTER FILL-IN MOTIF:** Repeat Motif thru rnd 3.

**RND 4:** Ch 3, \* dc in next st, (2 dc, ch 5, 2 dc) in next st, dc in next 2 sts, dc in 3<sup>rd</sup> st on next scallop; repeat from \* around; join, sl st in next 2 dc.

**RND 5:** Ch 3, dc in next dc; 3 dc in next sp, ch 1, sl st in center of picot of 1 free lacy pattern in center opening between Motifs, \* ch 1, 3 dc in bal. of sp, dc in next 2 dc, sk 4 dc, dc in next 2 dc, 3 dc in next sp, ch 8 sl st in next joining of Motif points, ch 8, 3 dc in bal. of sp, dc in next 2 dc, sk 4 dc, dc in next 2 dc, 3 dc in next sp, ch 1 sl st in center of picot of next lacy pattern; repeat from \* around openings; join and fasten off
